## CITIZENSHIP SERVICES

---

*Catholic Charities of Orange County (CCOC) provides free Citizenship Application services. CCOC is a Department of Justice (DOJ) recognized agency with DOJ accredited staff that assist the community with services pertaining to immigration and citizenship.*



## BASIC CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENTS

---

1. Be at least 18 years old
2. Be a Legal Permanent Resident for 5 years
  - a. Or 3 years If married to a U.S. Citizen and living with them



## CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION COST

---

- **Cost: \$ 725.00** payable to the “U.S. Department of Homeland Security” or \$640.00 if you are 75 years old or older
- Acceptable forms of payment: Personal Checks, Money Orders, or Credit Card
- **Fee waiver available** to those who are receiving Medi-Cal, Cal Fresh, Supplemental Security Income or are low-income.

## CCOC CITIZENSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

---

1. Watch our Citizenship Information Session on our website or YouTube
  - a. Topics discussed at the sessions include an overview of the Naturalization process, government fees, fee waiver program for those who are low-income and additional resources to help you study for your Civics and English Test
2. Download our DACA intake packet from our website or pick it up from CCOC's Immigration & Citizenship office
3. Submit Citizenship Intake to Immigration & Citizenship office mentioned in presentation, packets will be reviewed and analyzed by an immigration counselor
4. CCOC associates will schedule an appointment with applicant or ask for additional documentation
5. Appointment to complete citizenship application will take place over the phone first
6. CCOC staff will schedule an appointment to finalize and sign application
7. Study materials and information for classes to be given for Civics and Government interview
